
"Jamaica is not really ready yet to accept gays with open arms."

D'Lo - Los Angeles

A queer/transgender Tamil-Sri Lankan-American actor/writer/comedian whose work ranges from stand-up comedy, solo theater, plays, films & music production, to poetry & spoken word. He's been seen on HBO, Amazon, Netflix, & CW. D'Lo is currently in development on a scripted series based on his life that is set up at BTR Media & Paul Feig's Powderkeg Media.

Reverend Jide - London/Nigeria

Founding Pastor & CEO of House Of Rainbow CIC. Jide is an openly gay British-Nigerian Christian minister who is an inspirational speaker, author, poet & HIV Positive Activist. He holds a degree in Law, masters degree in Theology & Post-graduate certificate in Pastoral Theology. Jide focuses his ministry on inclusion & reconciliation of sexuality, spirituality & human rights.





Reverend Winnie - New York

Reverend Winnie is a South Asian queer priest who uses her calling as a social justice activist in all her formal roles. She was previously the Priest for Ministries and Program Coordination at Trinity Church Wall St. Winnie serves as the rector of St. Luke's Episcopal Church in Atlanta.

Tanya - Jamaica

Tanya currently resides in Montego Bay with her partner and is aiming to buy a house.

Maurice - Jamaica/Toronto

A Jamaican Attorney-at-Law, law lecturer, and leading Gay Rights & HIV activist in the Caribbean for over 20 years. Maurice is one of the only Jamaican LGBTI human rights advocates to challenge the country's 1864 British colonially-imposed anti-gay Sodomy Law (known as the Buggery Law). In 2012, Maurice received the David Kato Vision and Voice award which recognizes individuals who defend human rights and the dignity of LGBTI people around the world.

Serena - San Francisco

A second generation Asian American of Chinese heritage with roots in the Bay Area & New York City. Brought up in Evangelical and Charismatic ministries, Serena supports the spiritual and psychological well-being of queer Evangelical Asian Christians and their allies, and is a finance professional.



Lady Phyll - London

Lady Phyll is the nucleus of the award-winning celebration and protest that is UK Black Pride. Widely known as Lady Phyll – partly due to her decision to reject an Most Excellent Order of the British Empire to protest Britain's role in formulating anti-LGBTQI+ penal codes across its empire – she is also the executive director of Kaleidoscope Trust, an organisation working to uphold the human rights of LGBTQI+ people.

Jessicka - Jamaica

Previously lived and worked in Montego Bay with a security company and has two lovely children.

Justin Lovell

Justin's distinctive style as a cinematographer comes from his firm understanding of visual movement, composition and creative sculpting of natural lighting. He has been nominated by the Canadian Society of Cinematographers for his Documentary work and nominated for a CSC award for his accomplishments in Lifestyle/Reality Cinematography. His work has been highlighted internationally at festivals such as Sundance, Berlin Nomos and Reelworld, and has been broadcast on HBO, Bravo!, NBC, CBC, FOX, YTV, MTV, ESPN and TSN. Justin has also done socially impactful work creating opportunities for underprivileged families and individuals. Justin shot the Emmy-Nominated documentary, 'Jason Day: Never Say Die', CBC Docs' 'Player Zero', and completed two back-to-back feature films with teams from Suicide Squad, Triple X and Netflix' Marco Polo.

Kejd Kuqo is an award winning filmmaker and a graduate of the Humber College Film and Television Program where he majored in Editing, Cinematography and Directing.

Kejd's short documentary "Building on Sand" has screened at various international festivals and has premiered in OMNI1. Kejd's short film "Bosniak" has screened at over 25 festivals and aired on CBC as part of it's Canadian Reflections program. The film has gone on to win several awards including Best Film, Best Directing and multiple Audience Choice Awards. Kejd is the recipient of the Kenneth Post Achievement Award for Excellence.

Kejd's been a part of the Emmy-Nominated ZERO11ZERO ltd creative team since 2016 with such projects as "On The Ropes", "From Far and Wide" and is currently developing a feature documentary "Lazarat" on the biggest secret drug operation in Europe's history.
